conflict (konflihkt) *noun,verb* The main problem that a character in a book faces.

fictional form The form a story is written in such as short story, play, novel, myth, novella, etc.

genre (zhonruh) *noun* The type of story it is; science fiction, historical fiction, realistic fiction, fantasy, mystery, horror, etc.

influence (ihnfloouhns) *noun, verb* The effect of one thing on another.

plot *noun,verb* The main part of any story, which includes the problem, major events and solution.

resolution (rEHzuhlooshuhn) *noun* Finding a solution to a problem.

setting (sEHtihNG) *noun,adjective* Where a story takes place; date, time, location.
