**character traits** Things found in the story that help the reader to see how a character looks, acts, or feels.

**compare** (kuhmpEHr) *noun, verb* To notice similarities between objects, beings, and events.

**connotation** (konuhtayshuhn) *noun* The feeling connected with a word, in addition to its dictionary meaning.

**context clues** The words in a sentence that help you find the meaning of an unknown word.

**contrast** (kontrast) *noun, verb* To show differences.

**manual** (manyoouhl) *noun, adjective* A small handbook, it usually has instructions; a guide book.

**online resource** Information you can find on the Internet. When you want the latest news, you should use this resource.

**textbook** (tEHkstbuk) A textbook is used in school. It usually covers one subject.
